ANNUAL REPORT 2024-2025

Dear Members of SRBCE,

Good evening!

I am pleased to present the Society's annual report for the year 2024-2025, as approved by the Executive committee.

The Society has 584 life members and 32 annual members on the roll as on 13.03.2025. 2 Life Memberships and 42 Annual Memberships in our SRBCE during April 2024 to March 2025.

The **Executive Committee** was held on 15th November 2024 at Miranda House, Delhi University, New Delhi wherein; Prof. Suresh Yenugu, President, chaired the EC meeting and 17 EC members had participated.

Dr R. Devkar, Secretary presented the minutes of the EC meetings held on 15th September 2023 was proposed by Prof. T.G. Srivastava and seconded by Prof. Pradeep and was adopted unanimously.
